Beginner Puppy Training Course.

Starting at 6 weeks of age, this course begins with imprinting your puppy with the desire to learn and respond to your directions, leading to basic on-leash obedience training. This course is designed to teach you the fundamentals of raising and training your dog. This is the most successful time to accomplish your personal goals. The course is personalized with one-to-one sessions, which give you the full advantage of learning the techniques that are going to be required for your dog's successful training. The course runs for 2 sessions at your home and at your convenience. This is the most successful course that my customers enjoy.

Basic Obedience Course / Advanced Obedience Course

The Basic Obedience Course is for those beginners whose dogs are at least 4 months old and who have waited around thinking this is the time to start training. The course covers basic on-leash obedience, 15-20 commands and exercises, proper equipment and proper handling skills in a group setting. Social foundation and control are the goals of this program. This course covers 4 sessions and is a lifesaver for many dogs. The Advanced Obedience Course is for off-leash control of your dog under social or animal distractions. The course lasts for 6 sessions and is designed to cover proper equipment, proper voice inflection and proper handling skills. This course also includes interrupted commands and hand signals requiring the highest degree of handling skills. This is an essential course for personal protection, police patrol dogs, AKC and Schutzhund competitors.

Centurion Kennels Dog Trainer's School.

We offer training for certification as a professional dog trainer. This course is for those individuals committed in becoming a professional dog trainer. The course is for 'Certified Basic Instructor '. You will learn the basic instructor's program of dog handling and training. You will be exposed to the many aspects of teaching, handling and training dogs, the professional way. Written and practical exams are required to pass certification. A Diploma of certification is then awarded upon successful completion.

Group Classes:

A group class is defined as 3 or more dogs in attendance. This course covers 15 different exercises and commands in basic obedience. Classes will be held on weeknights or weekends at Reid Park. This is a group setting shared with other handler's learning the same basic's in dog obedience. The course is 4 lessons. The K-9 student must be at least 4 months old and owner/handler 18 years of age. I highly recommend this class. You will learn how to control your dog and how to change your dog's mind in many ways you didn't think possible.

Private Lessons.

Private lessons cover the entire basic and advance obedience program of 30 different commands and exercises.

The training locations include your residence, Reid Park, Udall Park, or Jesse Owens Park. Each lesson is set for 1 hour. Temperament testing and personal protection evaluations are also available.

Problem behavior is my specialty. (Dog fighting, dog aggression, and weak nerved fear-biters) Please understand you can avoid the "Dangerous Dog Syndrome" some dogs develop if you don't train at all or train with the "Wrong Dog Trainer".
